

Department 3 – Beef

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries shall follow General Rules and Regulations of the Hookstown Fair. A stall fee of \$5 per head is required with registration. There will be no refunds for no-show cattle exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. When livestock housing is full capacity, entries will be refused based on latest postmark date. No entries will be accepted after July 15.
3. Livestock must be pre-registered by July 15. Livestock for Departments 2 and 3 are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 21 between 3 and 5 p.m. and Monday, Aug. 22 between noon and 3 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 27.
4. All classes must be pre-registered, including: Get of Sire, Dam and Daughter, Produce of Dam. If not pre-registered, exhibitor is not eligible to show.
5. Every animal must be entered to be exhibited in individual classes (where only one animal is called for) to be eligible for group classes.
6. All cattle must be registered with their respective breed association.
7. No nurse cows are permitted on the grounds.
8. No original registration papers equals no show.
9. Exhibitors are expected to keep their animals in an attractive appearance and to cooperate with Department 2 & 3 officials in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
10. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the judging schedule. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call, and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing.
11. Exhibitors who wish to show a beef animal representing a breed not listed will be shown in this class if the animal has an official original breed registration certificate.

Note:

1. Crossbred steers shall be classified according to the breed of the sire.
2. Beef steers shall be free of infections and transmissible shipping fever shots required.
3. Because of weight variances and weight limits, the number of weight classes will be set by the fair.

SECTION 3 – OPEN YOUTH MARKET STEERS

THE OPEN YOUTH MARKET LIVESTOCK SHOW AND SALE IS OPEN TO BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE 7 TO 21 YEARS OF AGE ON JANUARY 1ST OF THE YEAR OF THE SHOW AND SALE.

1. A pen fee of \$10 per head is required with registration. No refunds for no show steer exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. Steers must be pre-registered by July 15. Limited space is available. All steer entries will be accepted in the order they are received according to their postmark until all stalls are filled. Steers are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 21 between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 27. Weigh in will be Monday, Aug 22 at 8 a.m.
3. **Exhibitors must read and refer to the Open Youth Market Animal General Rules. Rules 7 through 11 list the limits of market animal projects to be shown and sold. Entries may be limited due to space availability.**
4. The animal(s) must be under the ownership and the care of the club member.
5. All animals will be tagged at weigh-in with an 840 US coded official EID tag along with a sequential visual tag denoting the program.
6. Weigh-in/tagging will be at the Hookstown Fair Grounds.
7. All animals must be castrated (for Males), dehorned, and/or disbudded prior to weigh-in/tagging date.
8. All steers must be halter broke before weigh-in. They must be led across weigh scales.
9. To be eligible to show and sell at the Hookstown Fair the minimum and maximum weight for Steers is 950 – 1500 lbs.
10. All animals must be marketable quality as determined by show/sale committee.
11. All market steers must be naturally polled or dehorned to a safe condition as determined by the fair representatives.
12. NO drenching, pumping or force feeding of liquids will be tolerated except administered by a licensed veterinarian. Violators will be disqualified.
13. Show management will observe the handling of animals both in and out of the show ring and will have the authority to disqualify any exhibitor for unethical practices.
