INFORMATION AND RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

ALL PERSONS or organizations wishing to pass out literature or samples shall first obtain space for such activity, and having paid customary charge and have been assigned space, shall confine their activities to the space assigned.

<u>ALL EXHIBITS</u> must be set up and in place by 2:00 PM, Monday, August 22. Tear down will be Saturday after fairgrounds are cleared or Sunday, 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. NO VEHICLE WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS UNTIL THAT TIME. *THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED*.

INSURANCE - All exhibitors must provide the Fair with a current certificate of insurance prior to set-up of exhibit. Exhibitors must take reasonable care to protect all exhibits and displays from any injury or damage by water, fire, theft, wind, vandalism, maliciousness, or otherwise whatever may be the case or extent of the damage or loss. For this reason, all exhibitors are required to insure their display materials.

THE FAIR will assume no responsibility for damage to electrical or other equipment, or for loss because of power outages or equipment failure. You are responsible for protecting your merchandise during inclement weather. You are responsible for liability caused by your merchandise and or rental space.

EACH EXHIBITOR is responsible for cleaning his own display space and filling holes made in the ground. Each exhibit must be manned by 2:00 p.m. daily.

SUBLETTING - No space shall be sublet by any exhibitor.

SOUND SYSTEM - No public address systems will be permitted unless approved by the Fair Board. Fair reserves the right to limit loudness (service or public).

THE FAIR BOARD reserves the right to choose exhibitor locations in the best interest of the Fair, regardless of years as a commercial exhibitor.

<u>VIOLATIONS</u> - Violations of these rules or conduct contrary to the best interest of the Fair will not be permitted. Exhibitors or others who persist in such violations will be asked to remove their exhibit and to leave the Fair promptly. No fees or charges will be refunded in such cases.

<u>SELLING</u>- Limited selling is permitted only by Fair Board approval. Requests must be made when reserving space. No selling or advertising will be allowed outside of rented exhibitor area.

PARKING - No personal or company vehicles are permitted to park on Fair grounds after exhibits have been delivered. Parking spaces will be provided for exhibitors in a reserved area.

PRIZES - All drawings must be approved by the Fair. All prizes must be awarded at the close of the Fair. Drawings will be held on Saturday evening. Any and all trip giveaways must by approved by the Fair Board before July 1. Each vendor is responsible for their own drawing. A Commercial Committee person will obtain your winners information between 8:00-8:30 p.m.

The exhibitor agrees to abide by rules set forth by the Fair.
