Food Concessionaire Herby Agrees to the following services:

- To supply ample help to maintain efficient service for preparation and dispensing of food and drink items.
- Must use ONLY 20 oz. Pepsi bottles or fountain Pepsi products.
- Keep stand clean and orderly at all times.
- Follow all health food organization guidelines.
- Clean and store premises and equipment at end of fair.
- Fair board reserves the right to choose vender location that is in the best interest of the fair, and also to approve foods sold.
- Concessionaire is responsible for PA Department of Agriculture license and certificated food handler certification per state requirements.

Concessionaire must furnish a \$200.00 (Two Hundred) deposit and certificate of food products liability insurance by June 5, 2022 in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 (One Million). On your Certificate of Liability, the certificate holder must state "Hookstown Grange #1980, dba Hookstown Fair, 1198 State Route 168, Hookstown, PA 15050."

Hold Harmless / Indemnification

Concessionaire shall be solely responsible for any and all injuries to persons or damages of property or any other injury, claim, damage or loss of whatever nature, arising directly or indirectly as a Food Concessionaire. Concessionaire shall INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS Hookstown Grange #1980 dba Hookstown Fair and its employees, agents, and volunteers, from and against all liability, loss, damages, claims, and expense (including attorney Fees) arising out of injury to person or damages to property of any other injury, claim, damage, loss, cost or expense arising from them as a Concessionaire.

Personal Protective Equipment

Concessionaire must provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in accordance with CDC Guidelines and based on the Governor's Order at the time of the event. This may include masks for their workers and/or hand sanitizer, as well as social distancing.

Termination Clause

This contract will terminate in the event of unforeseeable causes that are beyond either party's control. This may include weather-related incidents, a government shutdown order, a pandemic, or another disaster.
