

# DEPARTMENT 6 — DAIRY GOATS

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. A pen fee of \$4 per head is required with registration. No refunds for no show goat exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. **Livestock must be pre-registered by AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup>. Livestock are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 20 between 3pm and 5pm And Monday, Aug. 21 between noon and 3 p.m.** They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 26.
3. **Dairy Goats must be neatly disbudded or dehorned per the American Dairy Goat Association standards. Other non-dairy goat breeds must conform to breed standards.**
4. Get of Sire shall consist of three does from a particular sire, with not more than one under one year old allowed, and not more than one animal from every multiple birth allowed. Get of Sire need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the sire's name.
5. Produce of Dam shall consist of two does of different ages, the product of one dam. Produce of Dam need not be owned by the exhibitor.
6. Dam and Daughter shall consist of a dam and her daughter. The dam must be owned by the exhibitor, and the daughter must be bred and owned by the exhibitor.
7. Best Three Females shall consist of three does of one breed of any ages. They must be owned by the exhibitor.
8. The Junior Championship class shall consist of the first- and second- place animals in the Junior Classes.
9. The Senior Championship class shall consist of the first- and second- place animals in the Senior Classes.
10. The Grand Champion class shall consist of the Junior and Senior Champions.
11. Best Doe in Show class shall consist of the Grand Champion from each breed.
12. Only does entered in the regular classes may compete in the Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, Best Three Females, Best Udder, and Dam and Daughter classes.

**Section 2A — OPEN YOUTH MARKET MEAT GOATS**

**THE OPEN YOUTH MARKET LIVESTOCK SHOW AND SALE IS OPEN TO BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE 7 TO 21 YEARS OF AGE ON JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> OF THE YEAR OF THE SHOW AND SALE.**

1. A pen fee of \$4 per head is required with registration. No refunds for no show goat exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. Goats must be pre-registered by July 15. Limited space is available. All meat goat entries will be accepted in the order they are received according to their postmark until all pens are filled. Meat Goats are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 20 between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 26. Weigh in will be Monday, Aug 21 at 8 a.m.
3. **Exhibitors must read and refer to the Open Youth Market Animal General Rules. Rules 7 through 11 list the limits of market animal projects to be shown and sold. Entries may be limited due to space availability.**
4. The animal(s) must be under the ownership and the care of the club member.
5. All animals must be tagged at weigh-in with an 840 US coded official EID tag along with a sequential visual tag denoting the program.
6. All animals must be castrated (for Males), dehorned, and/or disbudded prior to weigh-in/tagging date.
7. To be eligible to show and sell at the Hookstown Fair the minimum and maximum weight for Goats is 65 – 125 lbs.
8. All animals must be marketable quality as determined by show/sale committee.
