

# **DEPARTMENT 12 — HAY AND GRAIN**

- 1. Corn should be selected on the basis of uniformity of size, color, shape, kernel type, straightness of row and completeness of coverages, also freedom from blemish.
- 2. Small grains should be bright, clean of chaff, dirt, weed seeds, broken kernels and straw. Color should be uniform.
- 3. Exhibits shall consist of four quarts of grain in a gallon size Ziploc bag and are limited to one entry per class.

  4. All farm crops must be of the current year's growth, except corn and buckwheat, which must be the growth of the previous year.

  5. Exhibits will be disposed of by the fair at 10 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 24, unless otherwise specified by the exhibitor at the time of
  - entry.
  - 6. All miscellaneous seed entries must be at the proper moisture content for storage.
