

DEPARTMENT 4 — SHEEP

2024 RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A pen fee of \$5 per head is required with registration. There will be no refunds for no-show sheep exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. **Livestock must be pre-registered by August 1. Livestock are to arrive on Monday, Aug. 19 between noon and 9 p.m.** They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 24.
3. Yearlings born 1/1/23 to 12/31/23 may have no more than 4 permanent teeth showing at show time. Fall lambs born 9/1/23 to 12/31/23 may have yearling teeth present, but they must not be even with lamb teeth at show time. Spring lambs born on or after 1/1/24 to 5/31/24 must have all lamb teeth.
4. When sheep housing is full, entries will be refused based on latest postmark date. Note item 15 of General Rules and Regulations.
5. All sheep must bear an official USDA/APHIS ear tag or tattoo to be exhibited at the show. Sheep from flocks or the voluntary scrapie program must bear the official ear tag or electronic ear implant.
6. The combining of two breeders to establish a group class is not permitted.
7. A show order will be established by the committee. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to get a copy of the show order.
8. The "Other" breed category is for exhibitors of recognized breeds that are not identified by a listed breed category.

SECTION 2 — OPEN MARKET SHEEP

1. Lambs must weigh 80 lbs. or more.
2. Lambs must be born after January 1.
3. Lambs should be slick shorn within a week of the competition.
4. No distinction will be made between breeds or between purebred and crossbred lambs.
5. Lambs can be either wethers or ewe lambs.
6. Lambs entered in Breeding Classes (section 1) are not eligible to show in Market Sheep Class (section 2).
7. Limit to two head per exhibitor.

SECTION 3 — OPEN BREEDING / MARKET SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

1. Any Open Breeding Sheep (section 1) or Open Market Sheep (section 2) exhibitors may show a breeding or market animal in this class, provided it has been entered in Department 4, Sections 1 or 2.
2. Age is determined by January 1st of the calendar year. Class is open to exhibitors 19 years of age and older. 18 and under will need to show in Department 11 Youth Section B-4A.

SECTION 4A – OPEN YOUTH MARKET LAMBS
Beaver County Stockman's Club

THE OPEN YOUTH MARKET LIVESTOCK SHOW AND SALE IS OPEN TO BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE 7 TO 21 YEARS OF AGE ON JANUARY 1ST OF THE YEAR OF THE SHOW AND SALE.

1. A pen fee of \$4 per head is required with registration. No refunds for no show lamb exhibits. If an animal to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted if a slip is obtained from a vet.
2. Lambs must be pre-registered by August 1. Limited space is available. All lamb entries will be accepted in the order they are received according to their postmark until all pens are filled. Lambs are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 18 between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. They must remain on exhibit until released at 10:30 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 24. Weigh-in will be Monday, Aug 19 at 8 a.m.
3. Exhibitors must read and refer to the Open Youth Market Animal General Rules. Rules 8 through 14 list the limits of market animal projects to be shown and sold. Entries may be limited due to space availability.
4. The animal(s) must be under the ownership and the care of the club member.
5. All animals will be tagged at weigh-in with an 840 US coded official EID tag along with a sequential visual tag denoting the program.
6. Weigh-in/tagging will be at the Hookstown Fair Grounds.
7. All animals must be castrated (for Males), dehorned, and/or disbudded prior to weigh-in/tagging date.
8. To be eligible to show and sell at the Hookstown Fair the minimum and maximum weight for Lambs is 90 – 160 lbs.
9. All lambs must be slick shorn before show date.
10. All animals must be marketable quality as determined by show/sale committee.

SECTION 4 — WOOL

1. Wool exhibited must be produced in the area of the Fair, and the exhibitor must have owned the sheep from which the fleece was shorn.
2. No premiums will be awarded in any class unless exhibits are worthy.
3. Exhibits are open to purebred and commercial flocks.
4. Fleece will be exhibited in the **SHEEP EXHIBIT BARN**.
5. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
