

DEPARTMENT 23 — APIARY PRODUCTS

Rules and Regulations

- 1. All apiary exhibits must be the product of or be produced by the beekeeper exhibiting.
- 2. Exhibitors should make effort to exhibit extracted honey in its proper color class.
- 3. All apiary products must have been produced between August 2023 and August 2024.
- 4. Only one entry will be allowed by any exhibitor in any one class.
- 5. Bees, any race, one or two frame observation hive, judged on uniformity, of color of bees, presence of queen, brood, any honey, cleanliness, and appearance of observation hive.
- 6. All apiary exhibits will be accepted on Sunday, August 18 ONLY from 1pm to 5pm in the Tile Building at the Special Contest Table with the Fair Queen & Princess.
