DEPARTMENT 1 — HORSES

2023 RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No horse or team of horses shall be entitled to a premium unless serviceably sound.
2. No grade stallions over one year of age as of Jan. 1 of the current year shall be accepted for entry.
3. **All animals must compete or be shown one time during the week.** Horses and ponies with dual registration may be entered in one class only.
4. The fair reserves the right to refuse any or all entries.
5. All horses must be stalled at the fairgrounds for the entire week, or premium money will be forfeited. Stalls must be cleaned daily by 6pm.
6. All owners of registered horses and ponies must show original copy of registration papers.
7. All non-registered horses and ponies must be shown in an open class as a grade animal.
8. A \$20 NONREFUNDABLE stall fee must accompany pre-registration entry form. Checks should be made out to Hookstown Fair. No GROUP reservations or GROUP checks will be accepted; only individual and immediate family members will be accepted on each form and in each envelope. Reservation form must be from the current year. Senders of incorrectly-filled-out forms will immediately be telephoned and forms returned to the sender. No stall is reserved until the money and registration form are received by the fair board. **Cancellations MUST be made as soon as possible Melissa Law at 724-407-8379.** Any stall cancellations need to be made before July 16 or you will forfeit the \$20 reservation fee. Please note animal height on entry form for larger stall consideration. A letter of stall confirmation will be mailed to entrant when reservation is received. If a horse to be exhibited becomes sick a refund may be granted or it can be replaced by another horse if a slip is obtained from a vet.
9. When livestock housing is full to capacity, entries will be put on a waiting list, based on postmark date. They will be called in order if stalls become available.
10. The Horse Department Committee has final say on any disputes and the committee's decision is final.
11. Show orders will be posted on the barns. Exhibitors are responsible to be in the ring at show time.
12. **Riders under 19 MUST wear approved riding helmets anytime on a horse.**
13. All exhibitors must provide their own bedding, clean and strip stalls before they leave.
14. **Horses are to arrive on Sunday, Aug. 20, from 2pm to 6pm and on Monday, Aug. 21 from 11 to 4 p.m.** Horses are to come in Gate C by the Livestock parking lot. **Horses are NOT to be unloaded until original copies of Coggins, health and registration papers are checked by the department committee and all copies are provided to them.**
15. **The Horse Department MANDATORY meeting for all exhibitors is on Monday August 21st at 6pm at the horse arena bleachers. If you are unable to attend, you must have a representative present to get important information needed for the week.**
16. The Horse Department Committee reserves the right to assign and change stalls as needed. No permanent stalls will be assigned until 10 days before the fair. No stalls shall be painted, and all stall decorations must be removable.
17. **Class Entry Times:** Halter registration will be taken from Sunday 2pm until Monday 8pm in order to prepare for the show on Tuesday. Registration for the Pleasure Show and Game Shows will be taken on Monday up to the day of each show. Cost for all classes including halter, horse shows, and showmanship will be \$3.00 for each class.

4-H AND VOCATIONAL

Eligibility: 4-H club members must have passed their eighth birthday but must not have passed their 19th birthday as of January 1st. Exhibitors must be 4-H members carrying a project in the field in which they wish to make entry and be under the supervision of their State University Cooperative Extension Service by their designated deadline. Open Class rules, regulations and entry times apply for all 4-H and Vocational Livestock Projects. **All animals shown by a 4-H exhibitor must be owned by that exhibitor or have a lease agreement and must be carried as a 4-H project.** Be sure to use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat and dairy animals when fitting your animals for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat or milk. For exhibits, including live animals, please refer to the Beaver County 4-H Project Directory and/or the project book for project completion requirements not listed on the website or Department 10 information printed from the website. **EXHIBITORS MAY NOT SHOW IN BOTH DEPARTMENTS 10 AND DEPARTMENT 11.**

Note: Entry fees will not be charged for 4-H entries, only when the animal has been entered in open or youth classes.

Equine Health Rules and Requirements

All animals showing clinical signs of contagious, infectious, or parasitic diseases will not be admitted to any show or other fair event.

All drug and vaccine labels directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the fair.

PA Equine Requirements:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2023 is required.
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
3. All equine animals must be test negative for EIA by an official test within the 12 months prior to the opening date of the exhibition. Laboratory test results must accompany each animal to its final destination (a copy of the original lab report is acceptable). Foals less than six months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from EIA testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination.
4. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is **recommended** for animals three months of age and older. However, if a mare was currently vaccinated against rabies when she foaled, the foal is not required to be vaccinated until six months of age, with a second vaccination administered two-four weeks later. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. The certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the original rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

Out of State Equine Requirements:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 30 days prior to the date of the importation is required. If an animal comes from a state in which Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) has been identified, or a bordering state, the CVI shall include a statement verifying that "all animals identified on this certificate of veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis (VS). During the past 90 days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within 10 miles of a site where VS has been diagnosed."
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
3. All equine animals must be test negative for EIA by an official test within the 12 months prior to the date of importation. Laboratory test results must accompany each animal to its final destination (a copy of the original lab report is acceptable). Foals less than six months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from EIA testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination.

4. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is **recommended** for animals three months of age and older. However, if a mare was currently vaccinated against rabies when she foaled, the foal is not required to be vaccinated until six months of age, with a second vaccination administered two - four weeks later. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. The certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the original rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

5. If an equine animal has resided in a state in which Piroplasmosis has been identified within the past five years for a cumulative total of 30 days or more within the six months preceding the date of entry into the Commonwealth, that animal must be test-negative for Piroplasmosis on a competitive enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (c-ELISA) test, or a Department-approved equivalent test, with the test occurring within the 30 days preceding entry into Pennsylvania. The written laboratory test report, confirming compliance with the requirement described above, shall accompany the equine animal in transit to a destination within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and the date of test and the test results shall be written on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
